

Fidelis Academy Admission Policy

Fidelis Academy is private Christian School serving students PK4 to grade 8. Admission is open to students who wish to pursue their school studies in a safe and caring learning environment and who meet admissions requirements. Admissions information is evaluated to determine if the student is prepared to meet the school's academic and disciplinary standards.

Fidelis Academy admits qualified students to its programs. The school does not discriminate on the basis of race, color, national or ethnic origin, or disability in the administration of its educational policies, admissions policies, or other programs.

A student who has been expelled from another school, who has not met the academic requirements of their former school, or who, in the view of the Fidelis Academy administration, has a history of serious academic or behavior problems, will not be admitted.

Students wishing to apply from any state-approved school or home school must complete an [admissions application](#), provide the indicated educational records, and schedule an admissions interview. The following information is evaluated to make an admissions decision:

- placement/admissions test (when indicated)
- the admissions interview
- school transcript
- record of current grades
- recent standardized test scores
- discipline records
- attendance records
- recommendations from the previous school (when indicated)

All transfer students (Grade 1-7) are considered probationary students for the first semester of attendance. During this time, grades, attendance, and discipline are monitored, and the student's status is reevaluated at semester end, at which time the provisional status may be removed.
